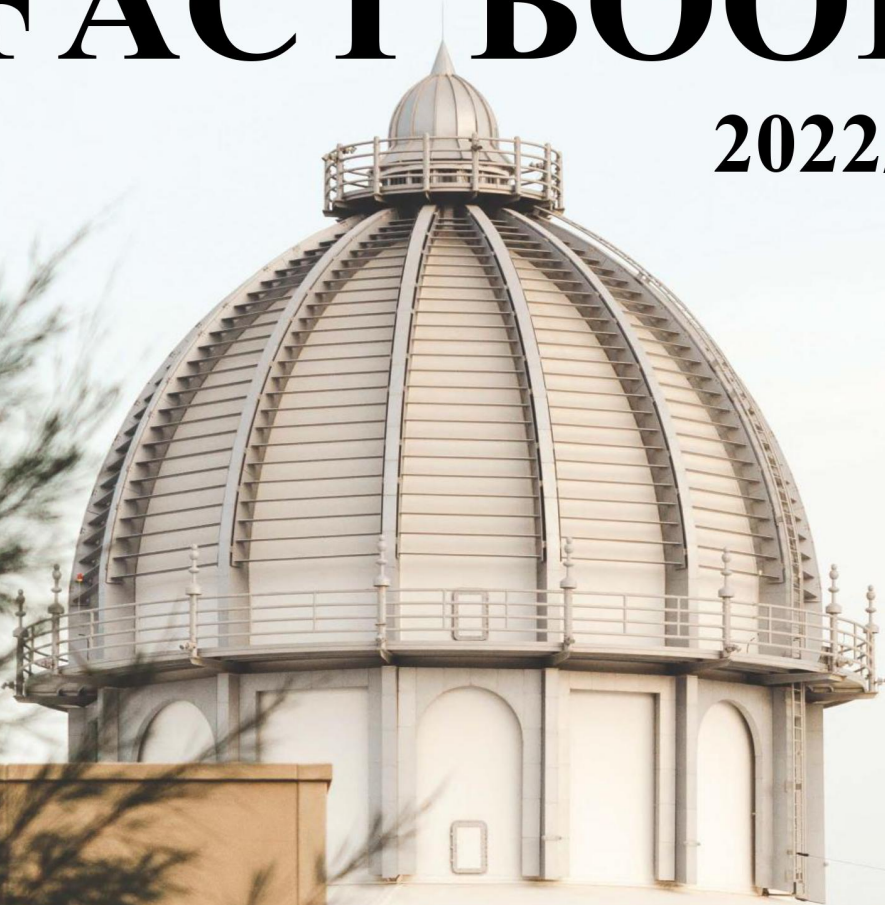

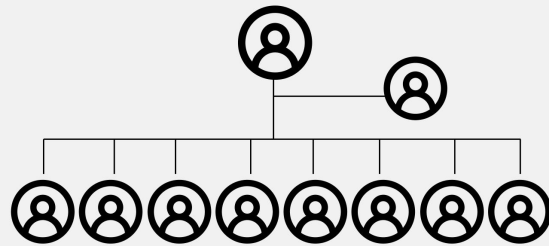

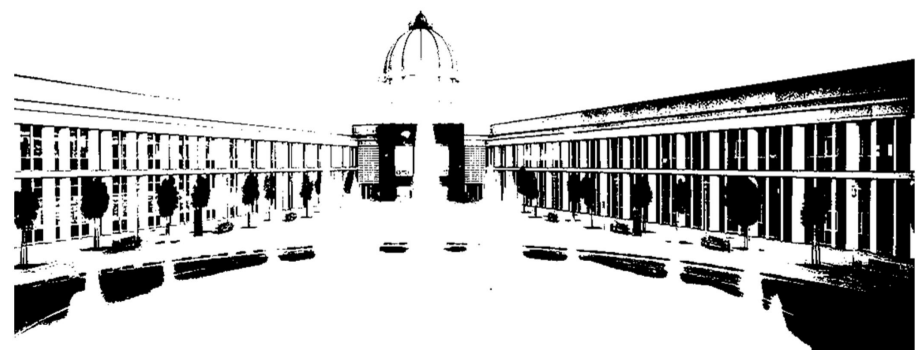

SUAD CURRICULUM

AY 2022/23



All undergraduate and postgraduate programmes offered at SUAD follow the academic curricula defined in Paris and comply with European academic standards. Each programme is overseen by the Conseil d'UFR of the respective academic department at Sorbonne Université (Humanities and Sciences) and Université Paris Cité (Law, Economics, and Management), and graduates receive their final degree award from Paris.

Undergraduate degree programmes are delivered across six semesters over three years with thirty credits per semester and a total of 180 credits awarded. All undergraduate programmes are taught in French, with the exception of the Bachelor in Physics, Bachelor in Mathematics with specialisation in Data Science for Artificial Intelligence, and the Bachelor in Records Management and Archival Sciences.

For all bachelor's and master's programmes taught in English, students must provide proof of proficiency in the language (IELTS).

SUAD CURRICULUM

Foundation Year

To support student's transition to university education, SUAD offers a number of Foundation Year programmes, the duration of which is a minimum of one academic year.

- For entry to all bachelor's programmes taught in French, students who are not fluent in French must register for the Foundation Year in Intensive French.
- For the bachelor's programmes offered by the Department of Science and Engineering (Physics and Mathematics), students must register for the Foundation Year in Sciences.
- For the Bachelor in Records Management and Archival Sciences, students must register for the Foundation Year in Records Management and Archival Sciences, depending on their level.

Postgraduate master programmes are delivered across four semesters over two years with a maximum of 120 ECTS credits awarded. All postgraduate programmes are taught in English with the exception of the Master in Teaching French as a Foreign Language.

SUAD's Continuing and Executive Education Centre (CEEC) provides customized executive education programmes, delivering high-quality, lifelong learning opportunities tailored to market needs. CEEC offers various certificate and diploma courses, such as Sorbonne French Language Courses (SELFEE), Professional Certificate in Archives and Records Management, and an Executive Diploma in Sports Management.

SUAD operates under the administration of Abu Dhabi Department of Education and Knowledge (ADEK) and the academic leadership of Sorbonne Université.

The degrees offered by SUAD are issued in France and accredited by the French Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation. In addition, all programmes are evaluated by the Hcéres in France every 4 years.

The Commission for Academic Accreditation (CAA) of the UAE Ministry of Education also accredits SUAD programmes. As of June 2022, all twenty-seven academic programmes delivered at SUAD were accredited by the CAA.

SUAD programmes have the added advantage of worldwide recognition thanks to the fact that they follow the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System and are therefore recognised under the Bologna Accord.



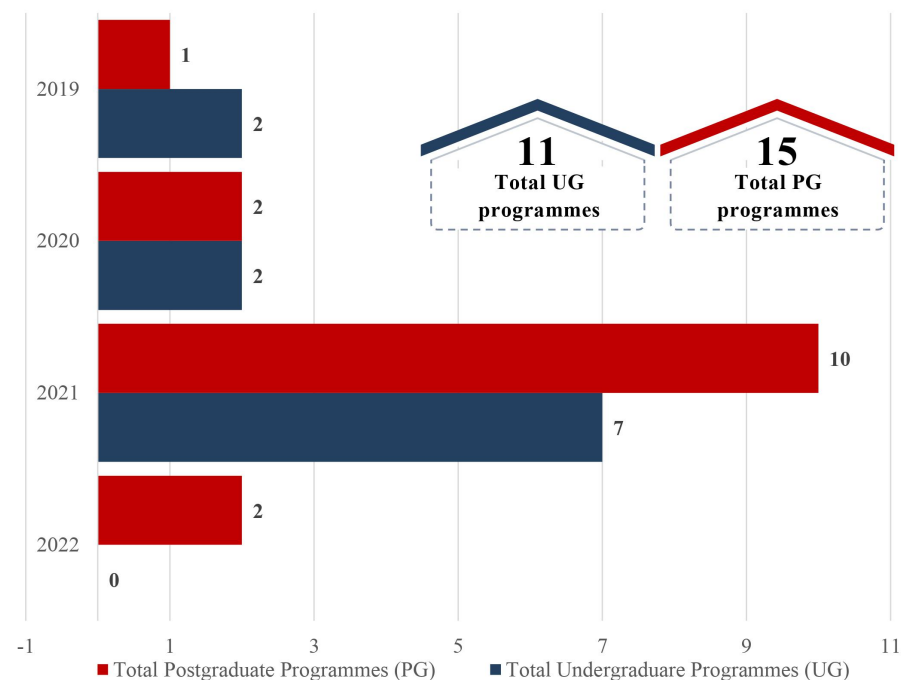

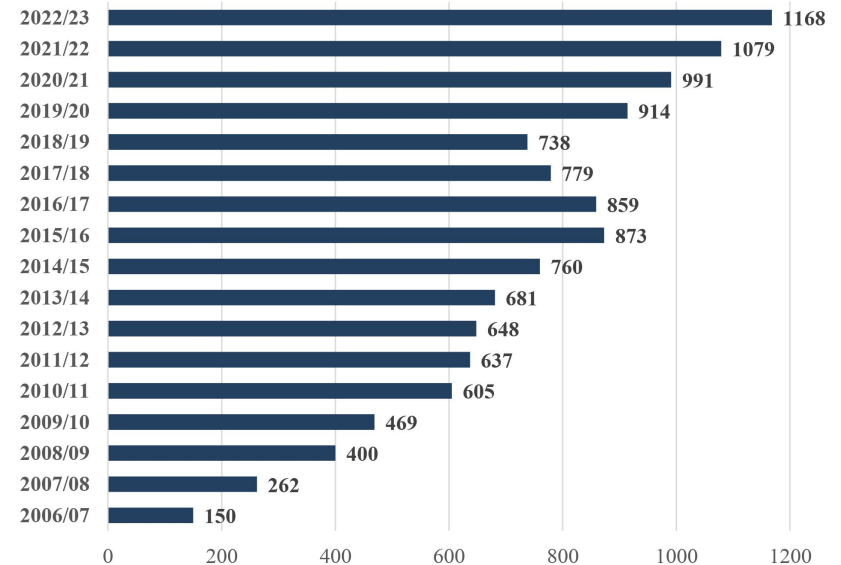
Enrolment



Statistics indicate a consistent rise in student enrolment, progressing from 150 students in 2006/07 to 1,283 students in 2022/23. Of the enrolled students, 64.14% were engaged in bachelor's programmes, 32.19% in the Foundation Year programmes, and 12.70% were enrolled in master's programmes. Additionally, 8.96% were involved in continuing and executive education.

1,168 students were registered in accredited programmes in 2022/23 representing an 8.25% increase from the previous academic year 2021/22.

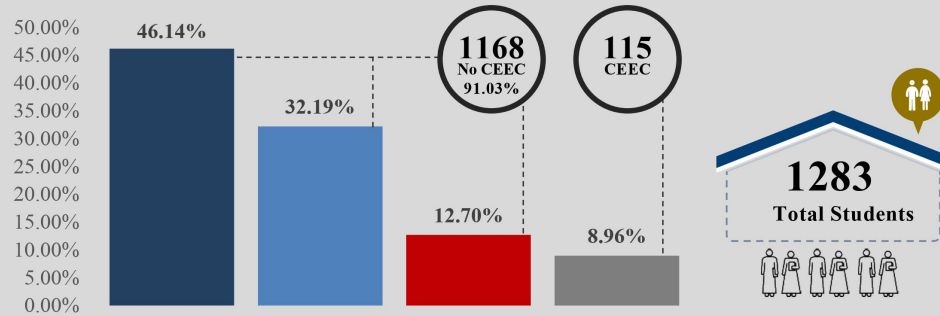
Enrolment Trends Throughout the Years – Accredited Programmes



Enrolment by Degree AY 2022/23

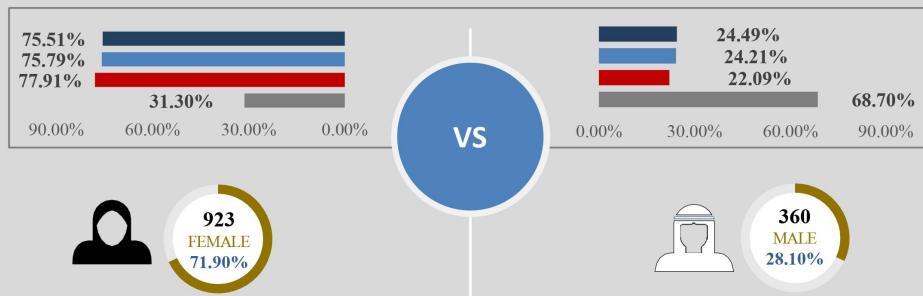

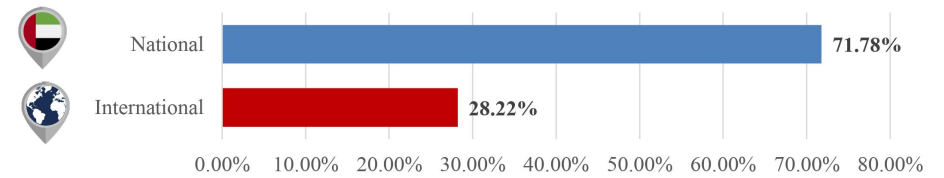

Enrolment by Nationality AY 2022/23

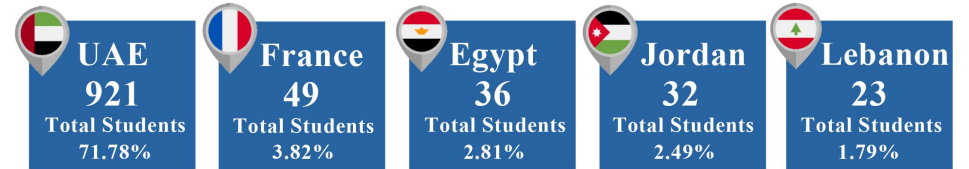

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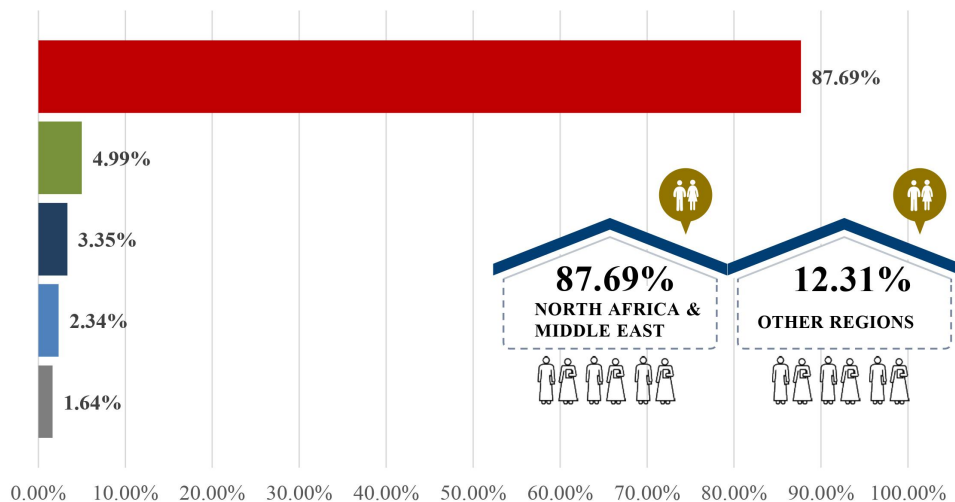
Top 5 Nationalities of Enrolled Students



Enrolment by Region AY 2022/23



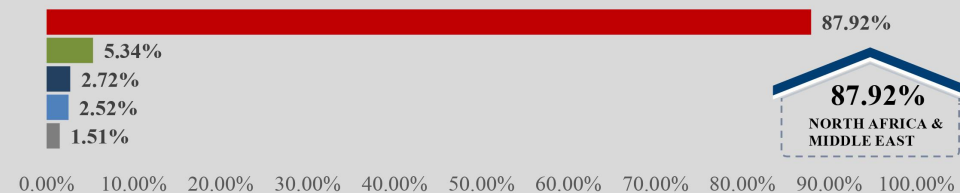

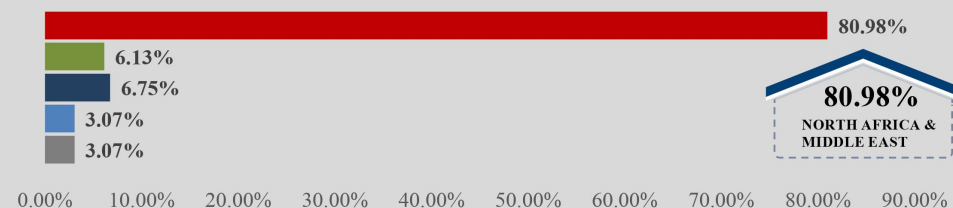

Postgraduates by Region Fall 2023/24

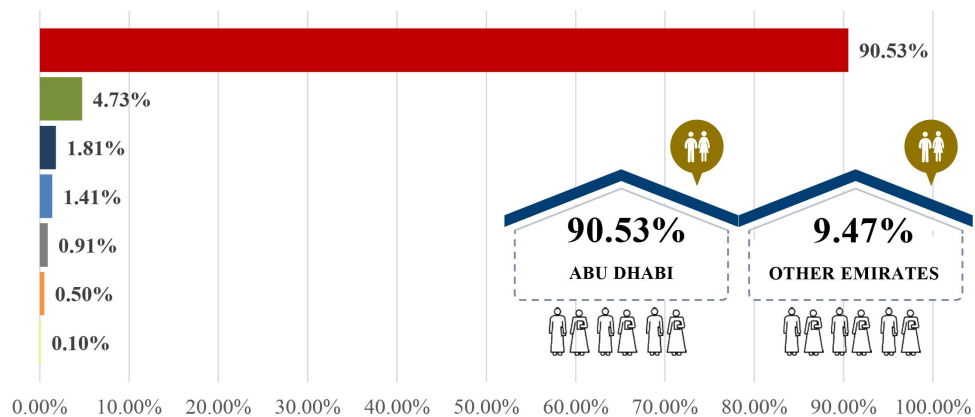

Undergraduates Enrolment by Home Emirate AY 2022/23



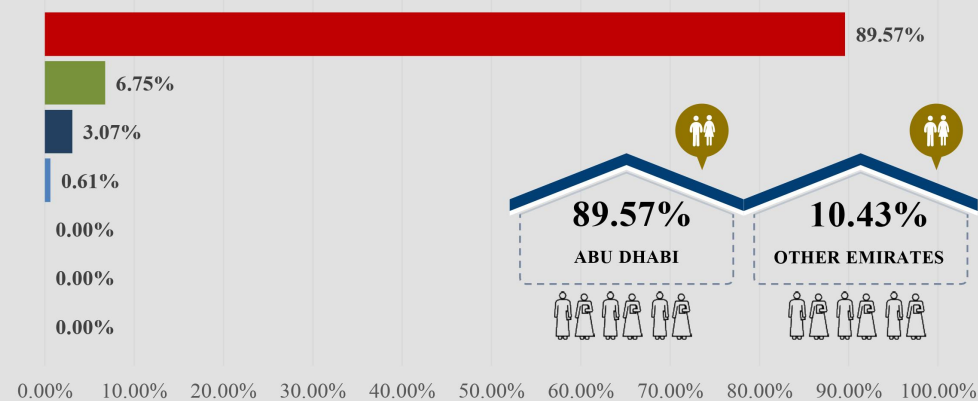

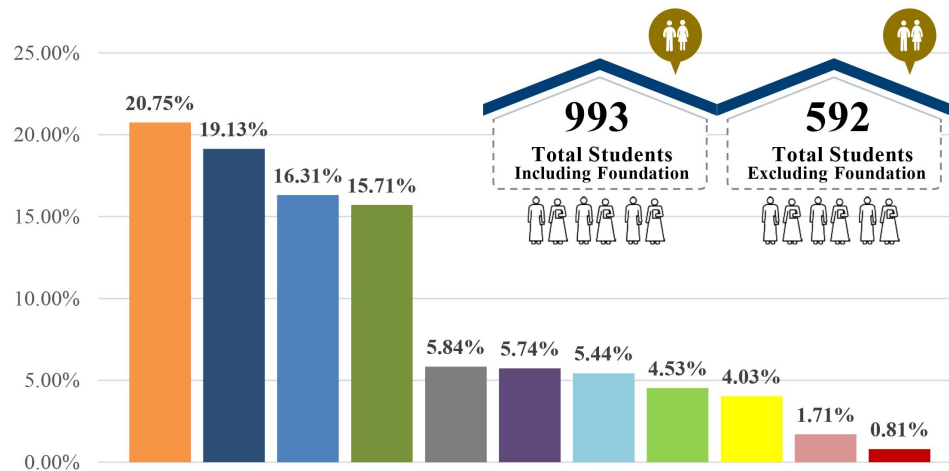

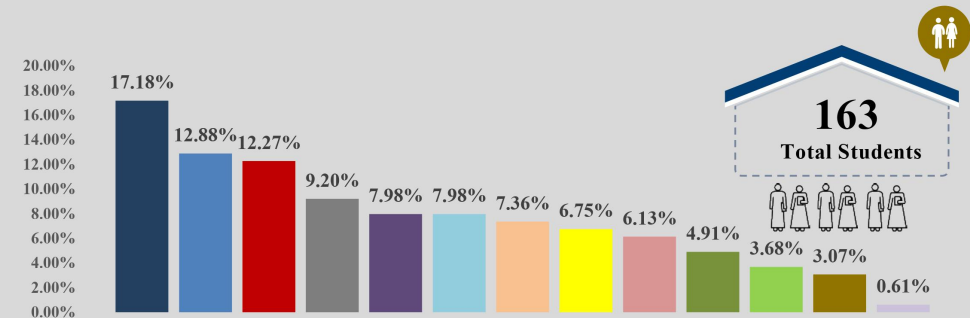

Undergraduates by Level AY 2022/23

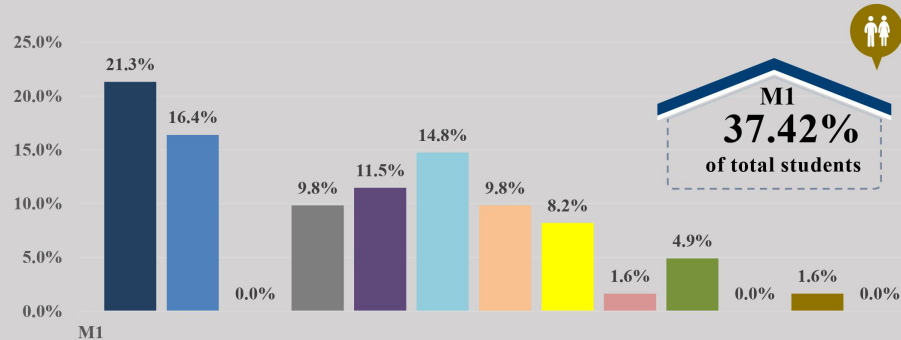


Programme by Level AY 2022/23

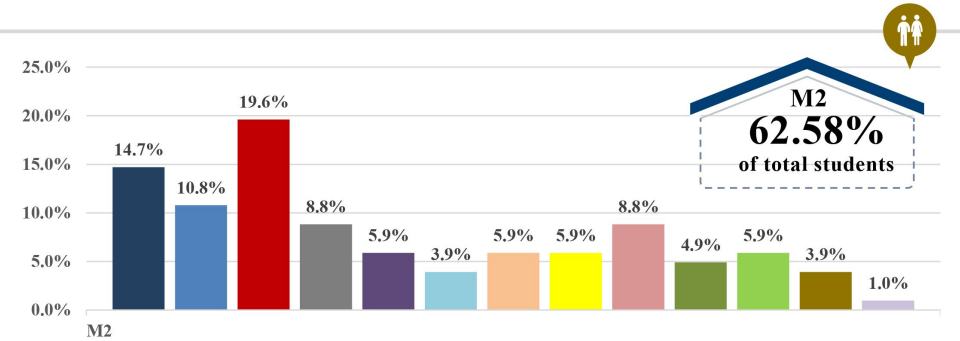

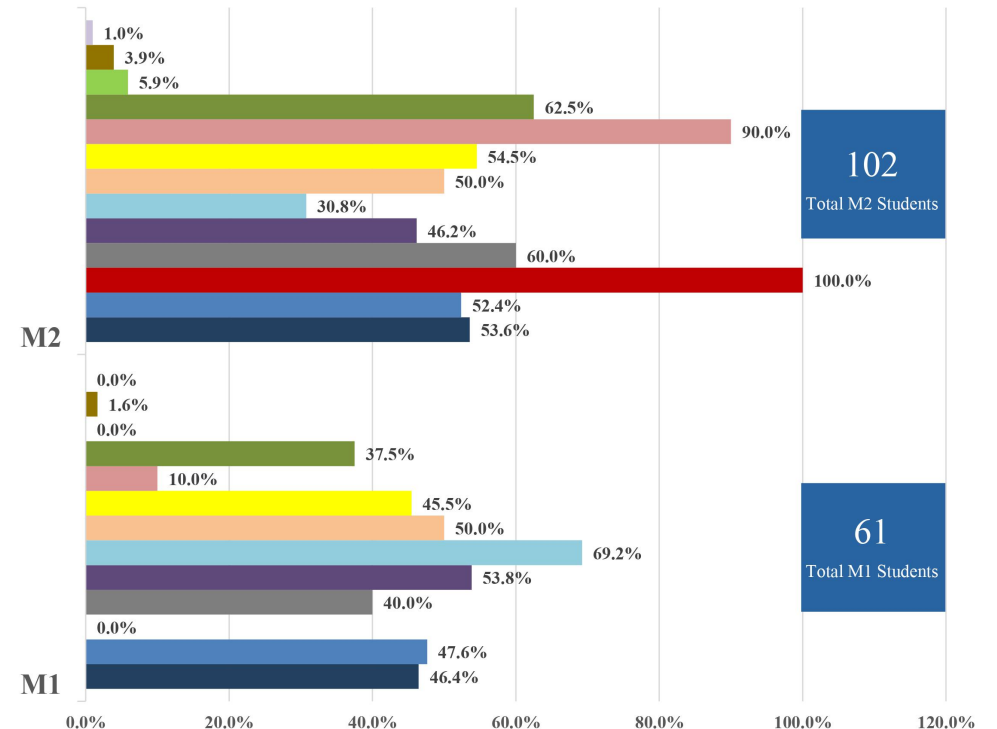

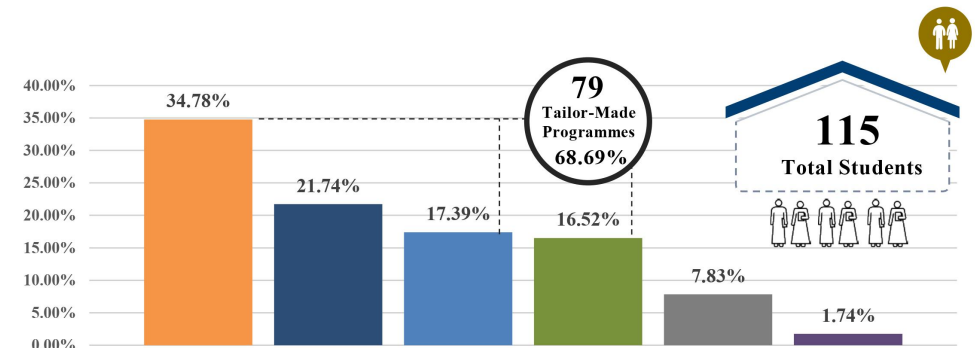
These niche programmes provide access to high-quality, lifelong learning opportunities and are designed to meet the needs of the market.

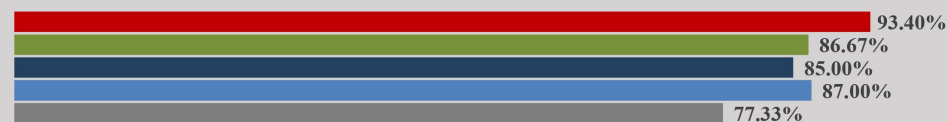


Fall-to-Fall Retention Rate AY 2022/23

Fall-to-fall retention is an important metric of success. Retention is defined and determined by calculating the number of students registered in the Fall of one year who progress and return to the programme in the Fall of the next academic year. Those students not progressing are either considered graduated, withdrawn or dismissed. Students who complete all the required ECTS each year are eligible to progress to the following year. No student can progress without validating at least one of the two semesters of that year.

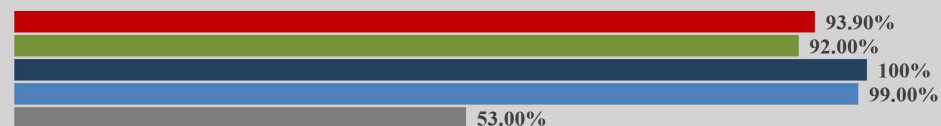

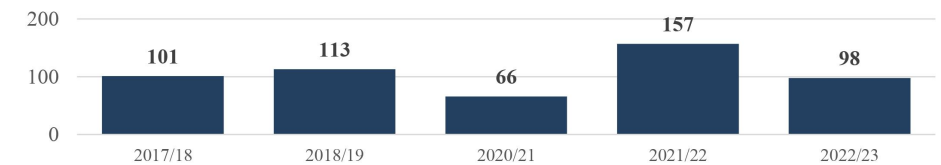

Internship Trends: A 5-Year Insight

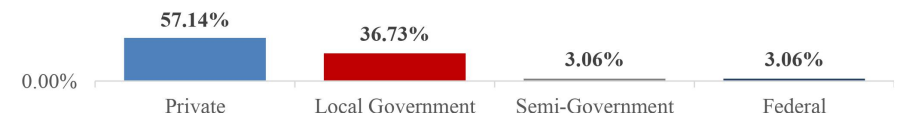


Internship by Area – Top 5 Areas

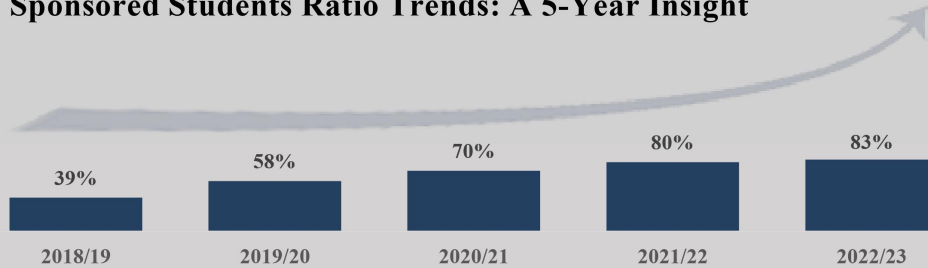

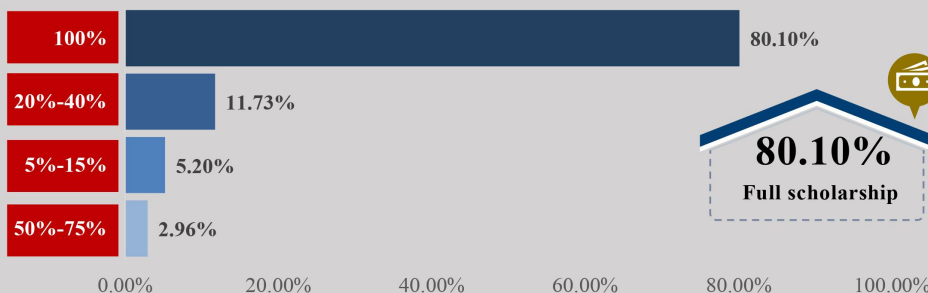

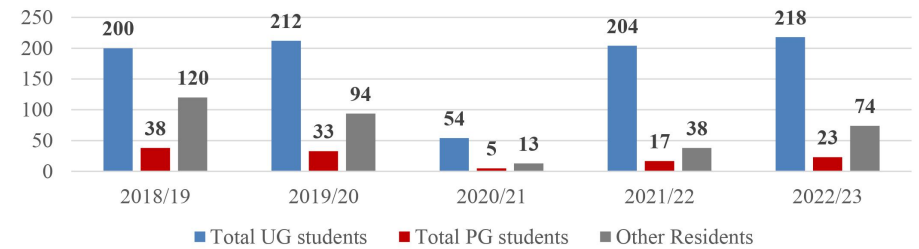

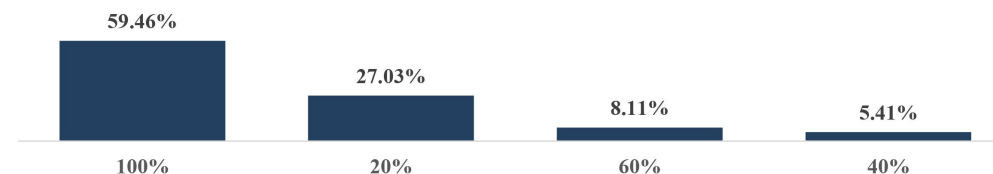


Students Who Received Housing Assistance: A 5-Year Insight

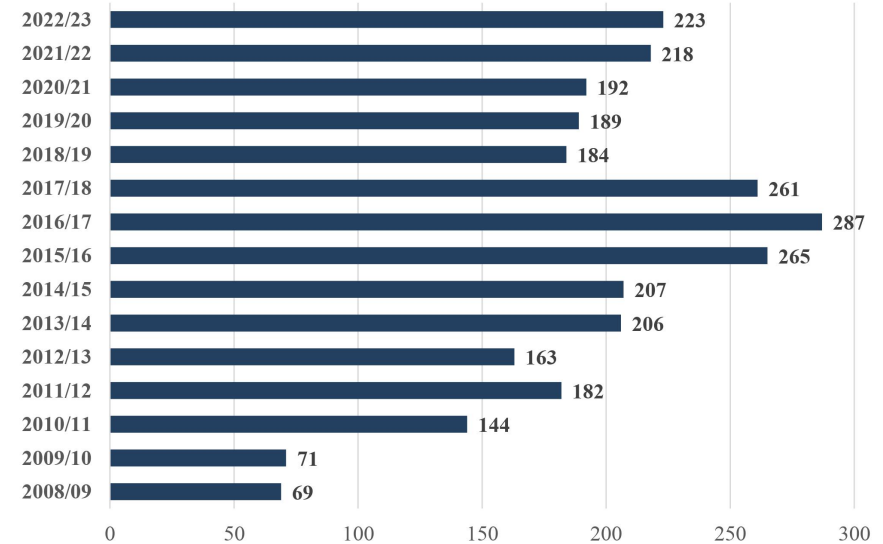

In AY 2022/23, SUAD graduated 223 students from its undergraduate and postgraduate programmes. Graduate Trends Throughout the Years - Accredited Programmes

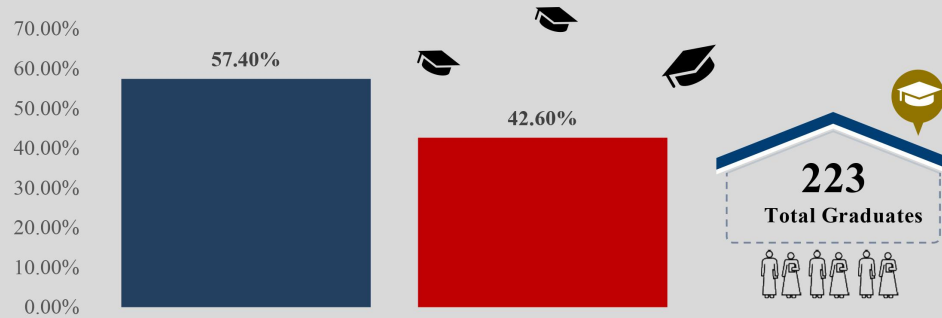

Graduates by Degree AY 2022/23

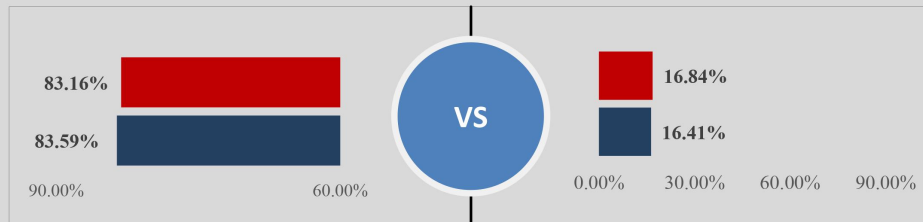

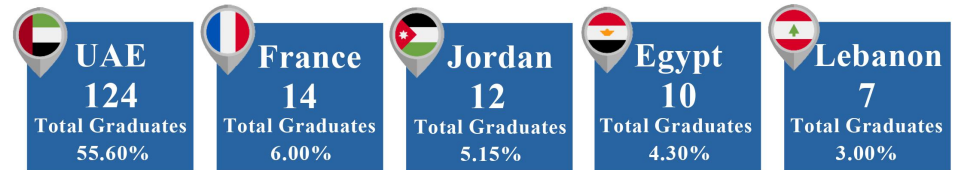

Graduates by Degree: A 5-Year Insight



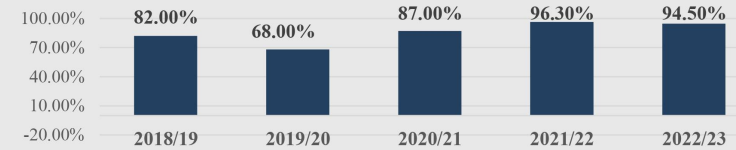

Respondents by Gender Survey Year: 2023

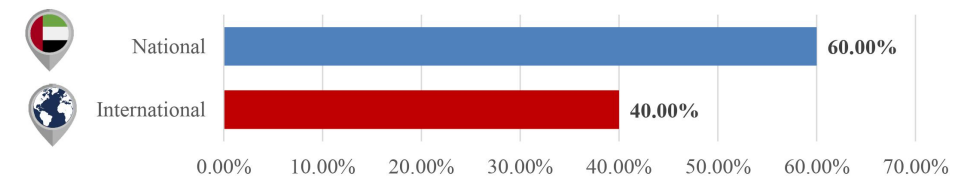

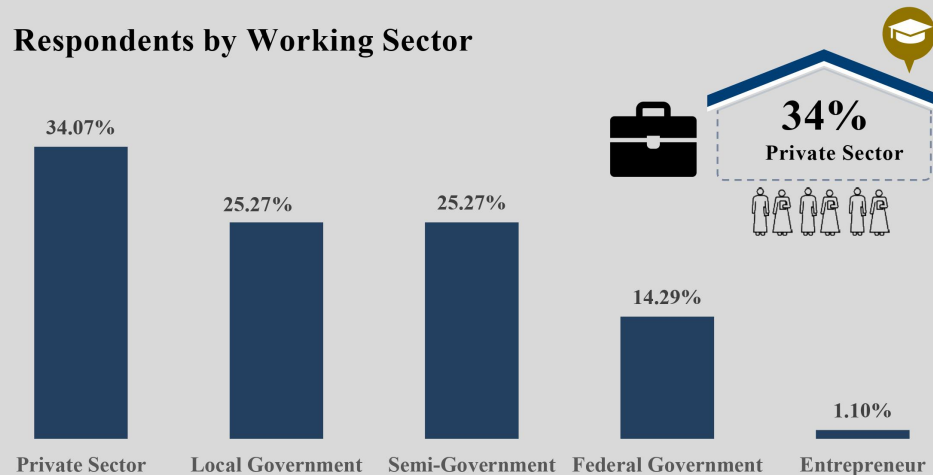

Respondents by Employment Status Survey Year 2023



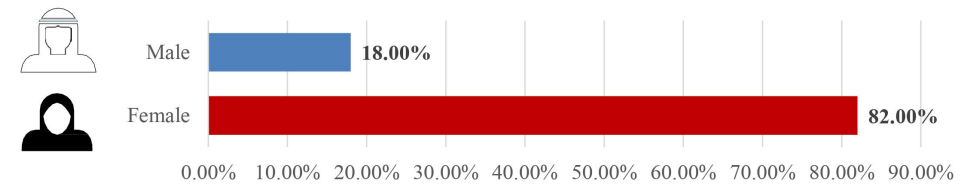
Respondents by Working Sector



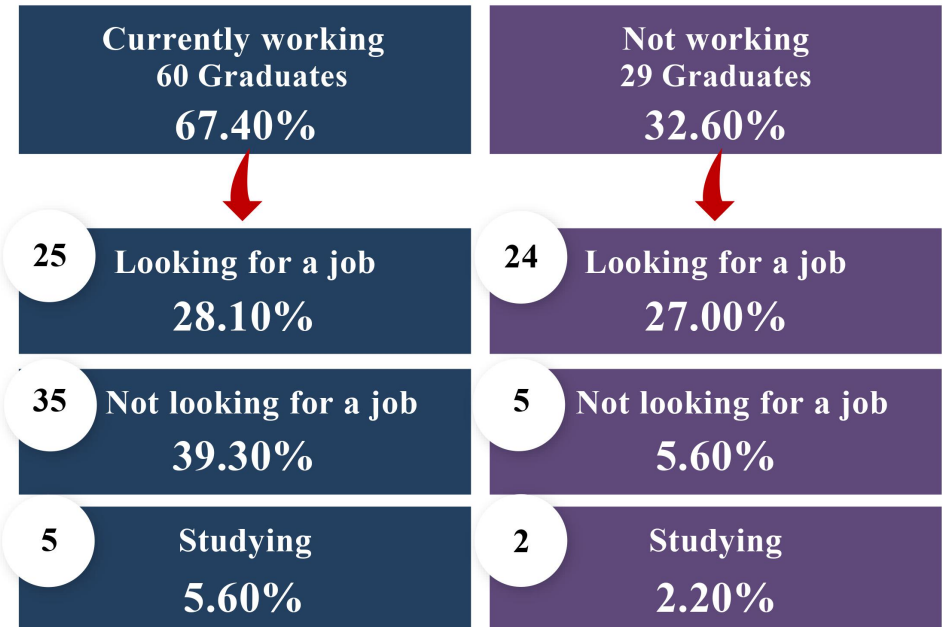

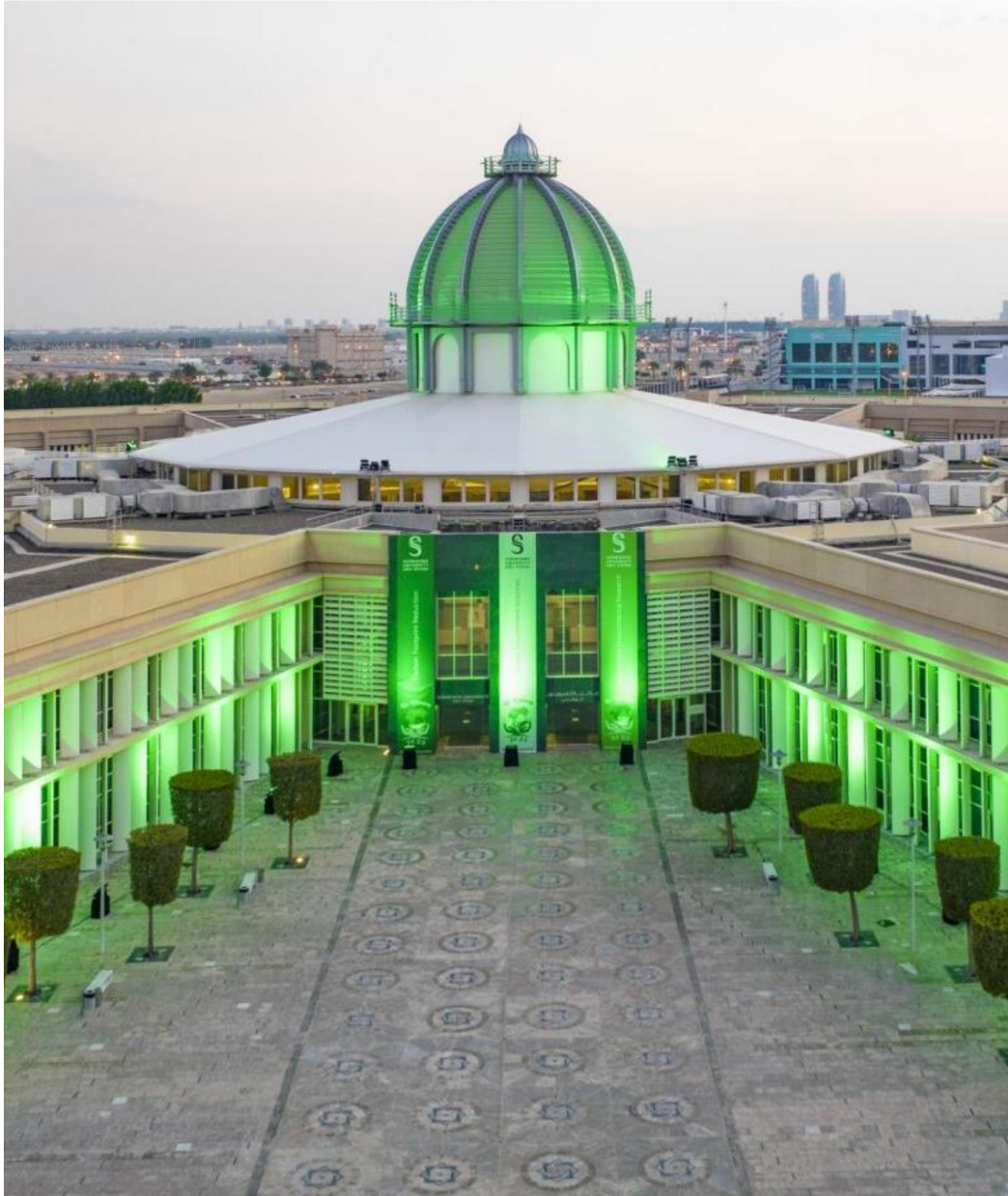


UAE Nationals by Employment Status



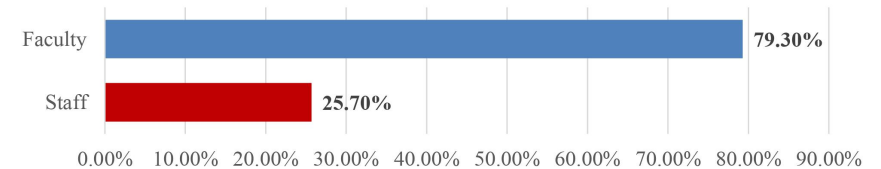

Student-to-Faculty Ratio

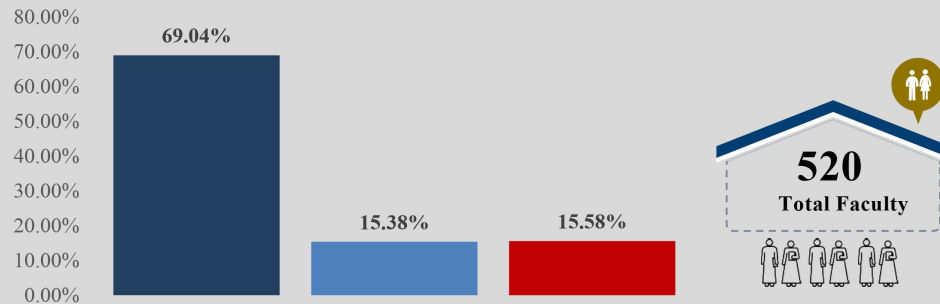

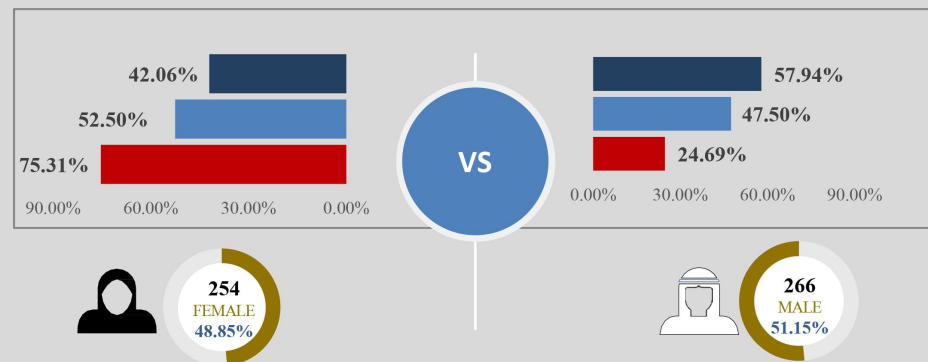

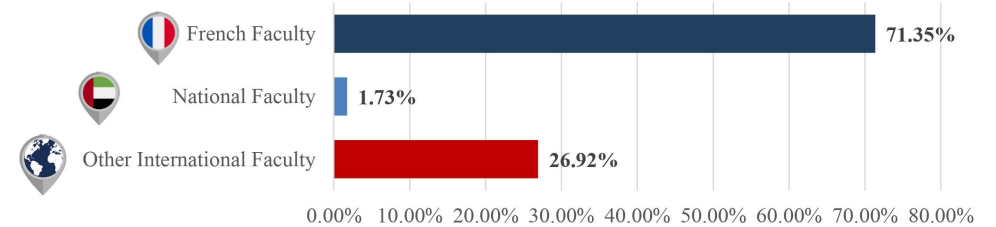
Department by Faculty Qualification AY 2022/23

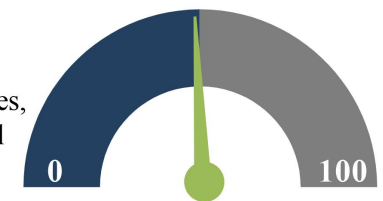

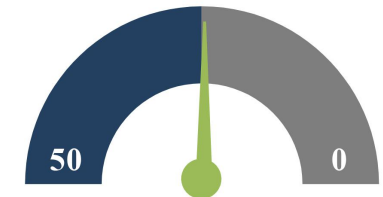

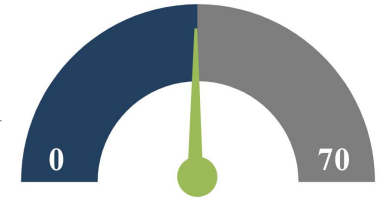


Staff by Nationality AY 2022/23



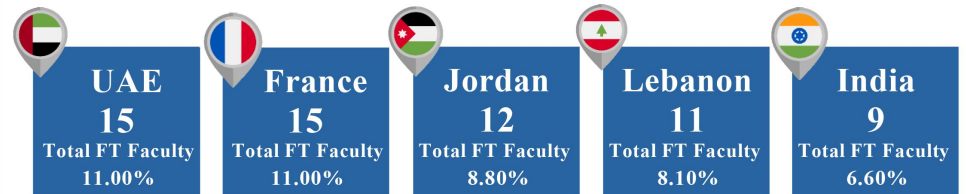

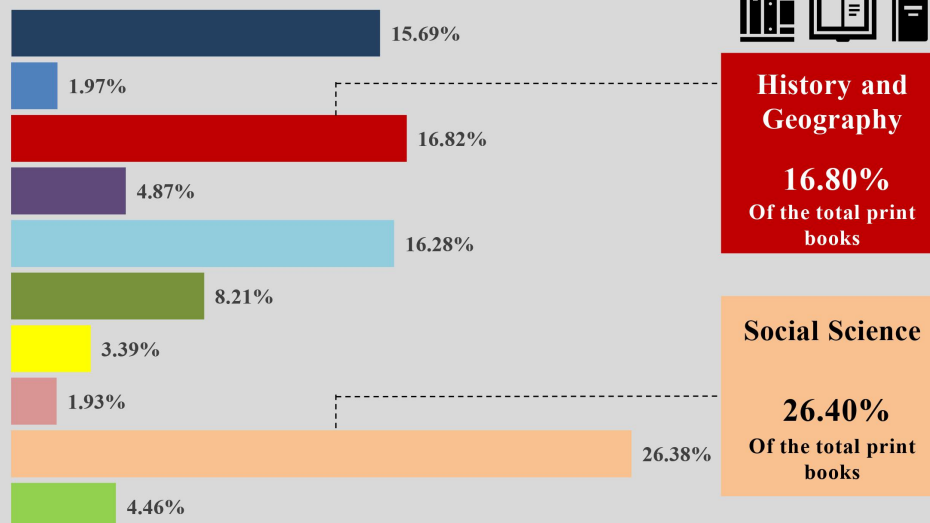

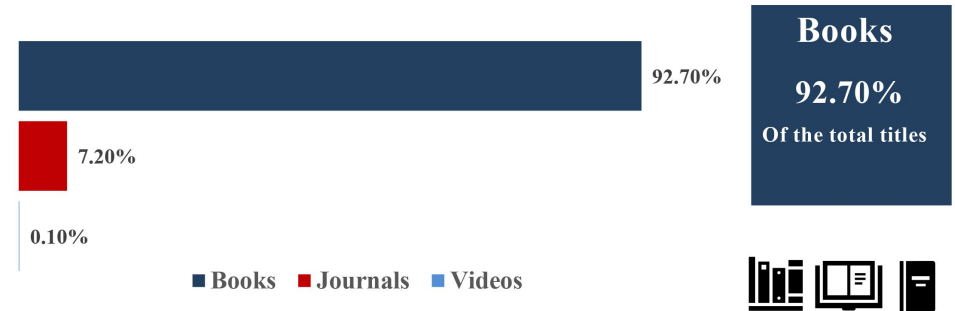

SUAD Events by Access AY 2022/23

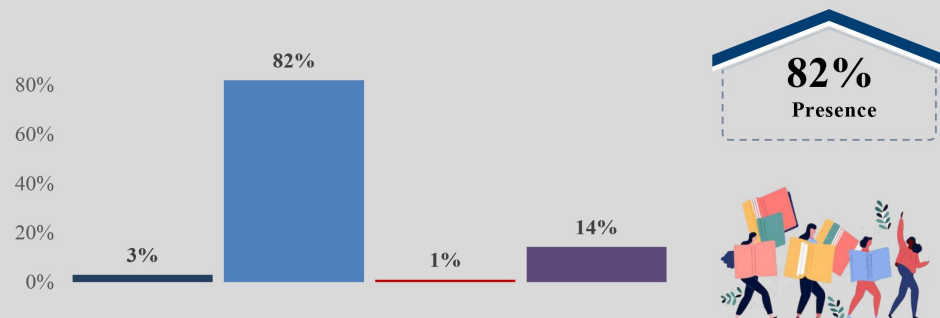

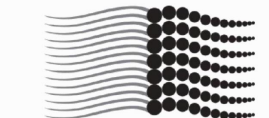

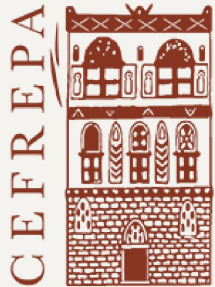
