overview

The **Professional Certificate in Archives and Records Management** combines six modules of intensive courses to develop professional expertise in areas as diverse as **legislation, conservation and preservation, management, classification, strategies, policies** and **procedures** related to the **archival field**. The certificate is offered under the supervision of the **Continuing Education Center**, in partnership with the **National Library & Archives in Abu Dhabi**.

This programme will incorporate a mix of **theoretical principles** and **practical exercises** for a well-rounded learning experience.

International experts and professionals in archives and records management will **deliver courses in Arabic**.

What makes this programme unique?

Practical and profession-oriented learning

The programme is designed as a practical professional certificate, not just theoretical study, meaning participants gain skills directly applicable to work in the field of archives and records management.

This approach ensures that learning outcomes are aligned with the practical demands of archival institutions and records management environments.

Expertise from international professionals

Courses are delivered by experienced international professionals and specialists in archives and records management, offering insights from best global and national practices. Participants benefit from exposure to diverse professional experiences, methodologies, and standards that reflect current developments in the field. Arabic-language professional training

The programme is delivered in Arabic, addressing the need for Arabic-language professional archival training.

By offering specialised content in Arabic, the certificate supports greater accessibility and relevance for professionals working in the region. This ensures that participants can fully engage with technical concepts and professional terminology within their linguistic and institutional context.

Main Modules

Language of Instruction Arabic

Duration 6 weeks

General Introduction About Archival Terminology (30 hrs):

- Evolution of documentation and archiving (history, theories, schools, international archival organisations).
- Archival terminology (terminology of document management, archiving, and electronic archiving).
- UAE institutions (administrative organisations of the UAE, federal and local entities, private companies, government-owned companies, non-governmental institutions and organisations).

Archival Legislation and Archiving Standards (30 hrs):

- Archival legislation (international laws, UAE archival laws and regulations, federal law for National Archives in the UAE).
- Archiving standards (defining the concept and importance of global standards).

Managing Current and Semi-Current Archives (30 hrs):

- Life cycle of documents.
- Records management and archival policies and procedures.
- Records management and archiving technical tools (classification plan, retention schedule).

Scientific Processing of Archives (30 hrs):

- Indexing and classification of documents and archives.
- Archival appraisal and evaluation.
- Search tools and research services.

Archival and Conservation Buildings (30 hrs):

- Archival conservation and preservation standards.
- Specifications of an archive building.
- Facilities of an archive building.
- Storage requirements for different media.

Electronic Archives Management (30 hrs):

- Electronic records management and e-archiving strategies, policies and procedures.
- EDRMS and e-archiving systems.
- Storage of e-archives.
- Micrographic technology.
- Documents and archives digitisation.
