overview

The Bachelor's degree in History is awarded by Sorbonne University Paris and is taught in French at Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi by internationally renowned professors. Students may choose between two specialized tracks : Political Science and Diplomacy, or Geopolitics and International Security. Prepared for understanding and analyzing the contemporary world, students can consider pursuing a Master's degree and a career in the broad field of international relations.

The Bachelor's degree adopts a multidisciplinary, global, and connected approach, spanning from Antiquity to the present day. Each course is selected for its relevance to current political, economic, social, religious, cultural, and diplomatic issues through workshops dedicated to analyzing contemporary events. These workshops are designed to decipher and address current events using innovative pedagogical approaches. Elective courses allow students to tailor their

academic journey by adding skill sets in digital humanities, digital diplomatics, research methodology, and foreign languages.

Professional development is a significant component, with the introduction of a mandatory 2-month internship in the final semester, either in the UAE or internationally, through our Erasmus+ partnerships. Study projects encourage students to engage with professionals through seminars and to work

on topics that help them consider their career paths, depending on the chosen track.

The courses are taught by internationally renowned professors who are recognized experts in their fields, meeting the standards of excellence and rigor characteristic of the French educational system. The program follows the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS), and the degree is awarded by Sorbonne University in Paris.

Explore International Study Opportunities

Starting from the second year of the Bachelor's degree in History, students have the opportunity to participate in an international exchange program for either one semester or a full academic year. Thanks to the ECTS credit system, courses completed abroad are fully recognized as part of the degree at Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi, with no additional tuition fees. Exchanges are open through a selection process to ensure personalized support and maintain academic excellence.

Among the partner institutions are prestigious universities such as Sciences Po Paris (France), Tsinghua University (China), Universidad Autónoma de Barcelona (Spain), Università degli Studi di Bergamo (Italy), University of Malta (Malta), and Universidade Federal do Pará (Brazil). From the 2026 academic year onwards, some exchange programs will also offer scholarships to support selected students.



Career prospects

This Bachelor's degree plays a significant role in the development of intelligence and reasoning which opens the doors to numerous career opportunities.

Far from being restricted to professions and training directly linked to history, this degree provides a unique opportunity for working in a variety of sectors including Journalism, Communication and Media, Political Science, Diplomacy and NGOs and Public Service and Administration. Graduates can also work in Education, Publishing, Heritage Institutions, International Tourism and Trade.

This degree provides graduates with several options to pursue further academic studies at Sorbonne Abu Dhabi and other overseas institutions.



Admission requirements

To be eligible for this Bachelor's degree, students must meet the following criteria :

- Minimum average of 12 out of 20 for French general baccalaureate or equivalent for the francophone curriculum.
- Ministry of Education curriculum:
General stream: minimum average of 80%.
Advanced stream: minimum average of 75%.
- Other high school systems: high school certificate equivalent to the UAE Ministry of Education high school with minimum average of 80% or equivalent .
- French Aptitude Certificate: Minimum score of B2 level (DELF or DALF, SELFEE, TCF with a validity of 2 years, TEF with a validity of 2 years) or completion of the Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi University Diploma (DU) in French Language for non-French speakers. Students with a French Baccalaureate are exempt from the language proficiency exam.

Students not meeting the required French Aptitude Certificate or students coming from ministry of education curriculum (technical stream) with a minimum average of 80% or for students with French professional or technical Baccalaureate with a minimum average of 12 out of 20 will be admitted conditionally in the programme, and enrolled in the foundation year in intensive French provided they meet the above criteria.

Upon its successful completion, they will be admitted into the Bachelor's degree programme.
