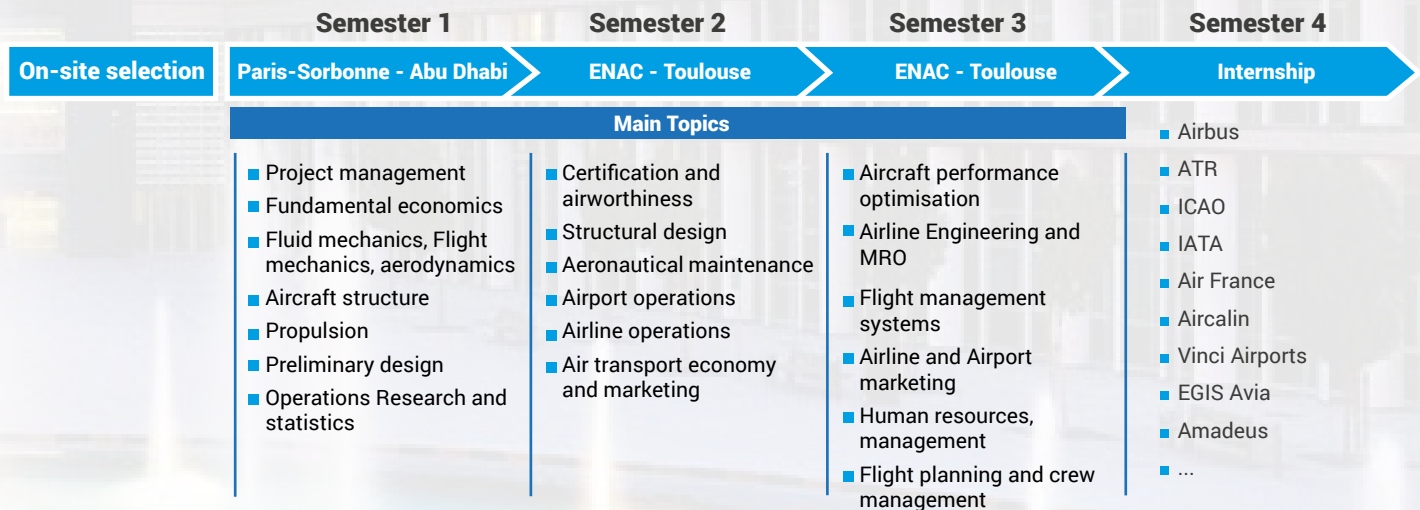


■ Main features
