Job Description

The purpose of this position is to develop and improve process automation and enhancements of systems including Sorbonne space system. The position will lead the changes and enhancements in Sorbonne space and related processes. The position is to enable IT to support the strategic objective of the university to transform, digitize and automate various business processes that are currently manual. As part of the business application team this individual is expected to have in-depth knowledge and experience in business analysis, software design, development, and support. The ideal candidate is skilled in ADSF, Dot Net, C#, XML, JSON, or any front-end technologies utilized on Microsoft applications especially SharePoint and Azure in an agile environment.

Key Responsibilities:

- Develop and manage Web portal in MS SharePoint Online with technical support.
- Work on automating SUAD's manual processes.
- Enhance the current automated processes and accommodate the change requests from business users.
- Develop various DOT.NET pages.
- Support and improve Registrar portal and Sorbonne space systems.
- Improve the developed IT system security.
- Develop Web based and Windows based applications as when required using Microsoft .NET as a development platform.
- Build the front-end of applications using SharePoint Framework (SPFx), HTML5, CSS, Bootstrap, JavaScript, jQuery Nodes, ASP.NET, XML, JSON or any front-end technologies that can be utilized on Microsoft Applications especially SharePoint and Azure.
- Writing codes using API and Restful Services with development of web-services as required.
- Participate in requirements analysis & collaborate with internal teams to produce software design and architecture.
- Build and manage designs in Microsoft flow, Nintex Workflows.
- Develop documentation throughout the software development life cycle (SDLC).
- Consult with users on best practices of using various technologies for automation, integration, and enhancing business requirements.
- Manage project scope, task prioritization, deliverables, quality, communication, resource commitments and integration with other initiatives.
- Track internal project milestones and supervise outsourced projects.

- Ensure that applications meet user requirements and system goals, fulfil end-user requirements, and identify and resolve system issues.
- Review documentation produced by development team for all supported in-house modules.
- Liaise between IT teams, vendors and other SUAD project stakeholders.
- Collaborate with IT management on project planning and reporting.
- Perform other related duties or assignments as directed by the Line Manager.
- Ensure project planning and documentations.
- Produce regular reporting on progress for management.
