Master Programmes

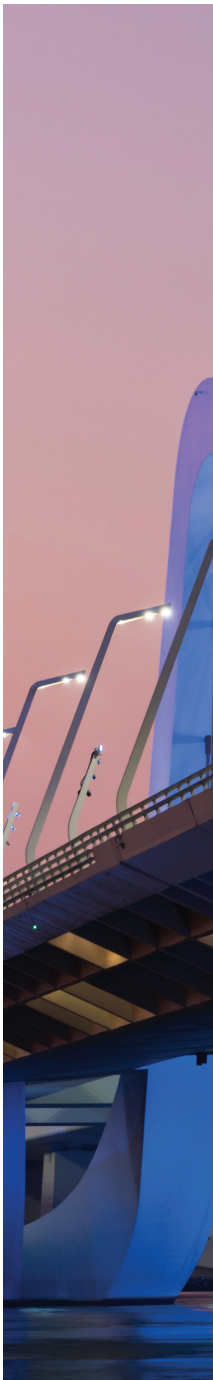
The 2 year Master in Urban Planning and Development degree is awarded by Sorbonne University in Paris and delivered by world-class academics in Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi. The programme is designed for students to acquire the fundamental knowledge and skills required for jobs as a professional urban planner.

A habitable modern city is only successful if its different components are efficiently integrated and the residents and citizens benefit economically and socially leading to an improved quality of life. Regional and urban planners strategically link the complex components of cities and regions including budget, legalities, availability of infrastructure and land and visual appeal. Through intelligent planning, they create plans to build and organically grow dynamic and functional public spaces for small and large populations. Planners work alongside engineers, architects, law enforcement agencies, environmental consultants and legal advisors to create vibrant and sustainable cities and regions.

Through master in Urban Planning and Development, students will learn about the role of planners, their fundamentals and ecological and social economic impact. They will study comprehensive policies, planning tools, technological advances like geographic information

systems, how to maximise space and merge form with function, organising metropolitan areas based on thematic and specialised specifications, among others. Students will emerge as skillful thinkers and problem solvers and refine their skills in communication and decision-making. This course provides students with a broad perspective and fundamental competencies vital for their careers as Urban and Regional Planners.

Our faculty is composed of Sorbonne University professors and external working professionals who have achieved worldwide acclaim. We also recruit renowned personalities from specialised institutions in France and the UAE as visiting lecturers. Students will be guided to explore the most effective strategies related to sustainable land-use and public spaces, transportation, safety concerns, GIS technologies and advanced-planning systems that shape the cities of tomorrow.

The programme in Abu Dhabi is offered under the Sorbonne Urban Planning and Development Institute (Paris) which was created over 25 years ago. The degree in Urban Planning and Development is taught in English and covers a total of four semesters across two years. The course schedule is carefully designed to accommodate working professionals by arranging classes over short periods, including weekends, in consideration of students who intend to combine their studies with work.

Master's thesis

Non-employed students will be required to submit an extended essay based on their internship. Full-time employed students will be required to submit a research based thesis.

Internship

For nonworking students, Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi has integrated a mandatory internship in the second year.

The internship will encourage critical thinking and improve students' reasoning abilities by blending academic theory with real life work experience. Students will benefit from a greater depth of experience working in a professional environment.

Students will discover that this collaborative learning process can lead to enduring professional relationships, which will open doors and forge new career paths.

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Assessment & graduation requirements

Throughout the year, there will be frequent assessment and evaluations. Students will be evaluated on individual assignments, internships presentations, reports and examinations, which usually take place towards the end of every semester. Attendance to all classes is mandatory and it is important that students are punctual and observe university regulations at all times.





Career prospects

Admission to our master's programmes is selective and competitive and each applicant will be considered on his/her own merit. Our admissions process ensures that every course has an ideal mix of people with talent, impressive interpersonal skills and a positive attitude.

Admission requirements

General entry requirements:

- Bachelor in a relevant field with a CGPA of 3 out of 4 or equivalent. Candidates with a GPA between 2.5 and 2.99 (or equivalent scores as per the equivalency table) may be conditionally admitted under probation during the first semester. The student will be authorized to continue in the program only if they secure an average of at least 12 out of 20 which is obtained by the end of the first semester. The decision is based on academic performance and will be made official after the completion of the first semester
- or
- Bachelor with minimum of 2nd class honours
- or
- Bachelor with an average of 12 out of 20
- Bachelor students with a GPA below 3 may be admitted on the ground of their professional and/or personal experience, in case they are granted a VAPP by SU's or UP's VAPP commission
- IELTS certificate with minimum overall band of 6.0 with a validity of 2 years or TOEFL certificate with minimum score of 79 (or equivalent) with a validity of 2 years
- or Minimum EmSAT English score of 1400 with a validity of 18 months or, Native English speaker who completed 3 full years in an English-medium institution within a maximum period of 3 years
- A minimum 3 years relevant professional experience, applicants not having a minimum of 3 years relevant professional experience will be required to pass the entry test (oral examination)
- Shortlisted candidates will be asked to attend an interview to assess the candidate's motivation, career expectations and relevant professional experience in the degree area.

Applicants who earned their undergraduate degrees from universities outside the UAE must present a Certificate of Equivalency for their graduation certificates from the UAE Ministry of Education. Applicants, who are holders of undergraduate degrees issued by a licensed higher education institution in the UAE, are required to submit a copy of their degrees attested by the UAE Ministry of Education.
