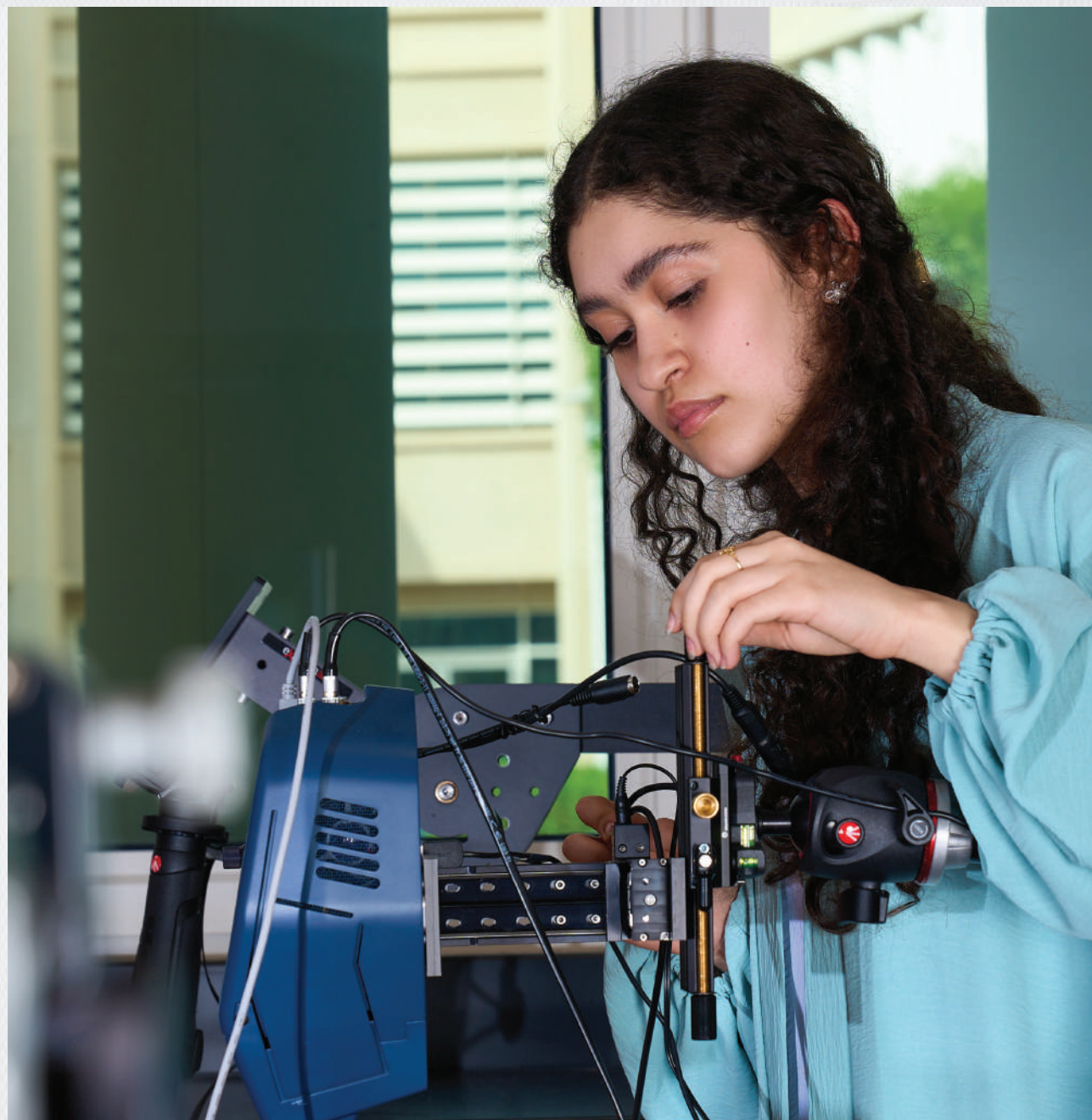




## I. DEVELOP RESEARCH WITH IMPACT

### Strategies

In a transdisciplinary university such as Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi, our primary goal is to foster impactful research that aligns with the national priorities of the UAE, and global challenges. This commitment will drive a comprehensive and collaborative strategy that transcends traditional academic boundaries and engages stakeholders beyond academia. To achieve this vision, we have outlined a multifaceted approach.



#### RESEARCH INCENTIVES AND SUPPORT

To develop research capacity, we are committed to offering a range of incentives and support. These have the dual purpose of increasing the number of researchers across our diverse institutes, laboratories, and research centres and of encouraging greater participation in cross-disciplinary work. These measures will extend to doctoral and post-doctoral fellows, as well as to experienced researchers who will provide research supervision.

#### COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH PARTNERSHIPS

Stakeholder engagement is also a pivotal aspect of our strategy. We will actively develop new strategic partnerships with external stakeholders in industry, government, and NGOs to create a forum for defining research priorities and co-creating innovative solutions in line with the Sustainable Development Goals set by the United Nations, as well as with local and international socio-economic needs and expectations.

#### RESEARCH IMPACT ASSESSMENT METRICS

Our commitment to rigorous impact assessment is unwavering. At SUAD, we will develop and implement a range of metrics that go beyond conventional academic measures, encompassing societal, economic, and environmental impacts. These metrics will serve as a barometer of our progress.

#### ESTABLISH A RESEARCH SUPPORT CENTRE

To provide comprehensive support for our growing research community, we will establish a dedicated research support centre to assist and promote the activities of the SUAD Research Institute.

#### BUILDING A RESEARCH POOL OF EXCELLENCE

Recruiting, supporting, and retaining staff actively engaged in research is a top priority for SUAD. We will align new academic appointments with thematic research priorities and offer guidance through research mentoring.

SUAD is committed to establishing clear research expectations for faculty members, ensuring that they have access to the necessary support to thrive in their research endeavours. Through these integrated efforts and plans, we aim to enhance research impact and ensure that our institution plays a significant role in advancing the national priorities of the UAE, and promoting a culture of innovation, collaboration, and excellence.



## II. BUILD INTERDISCIPLINARY, TRANSNATIONAL COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH

### Strategies

Our objective, at SUAD, is to establish ourselves as leaders, not only in our region but on a global scale by engaging in collaborative and international research initiatives aimed at addressing complex challenges that transcend geographical and disciplinary boundaries. To attain this vision, several critical steps have been identified.

First and foremost, it is imperative that we collectively define the specific objectives of our transdisciplinary research strategy. This will involve determining which areas of research will take precedence and identifying the global challenges and themes in which our researchers can provide expertise. SUAD's research objectives will be aligned with both the disciplines and fields of excellence of Sorbonne Université (SU) and Université Paris Cité (UPC), and the needs of the market in which it operates.

In summary, SUAD's strategic objectives are designed to bridge the gap between academic research and the needs of industry and society. The university intends to develop partnerships, consultancy services, diversified funding sources, and innovation incubators to ensure that its research activities have a real-world impact and contribute to socio-economic growth and competitiveness on a global scale.

We will host, establish, and promote specialized and transdisciplinary research centres and institutes, such as:

#### SUAD RESEARCH CENTRES

##### **Sorbonne Centre for Artificial Intelligence (Scai)**

A transdisciplinary institute for artificial intelligence, which has the resources in both the sciences and the humanities to develop excellent research in artificial intelligence.

##### **The French Research Centre of the Arabian Peninsula (CEFREPA)**

A research center with a regional vocation, which aims to support research carried out on the entire Arabian Peninsula. It is part of the network of French research institutes abroad (Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs & CNRS), which is made up of 27 institutions present in more than 30 countries.

##### **The Ocean Institute**

The Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi Ocean Institute aims to develop research and education to support the holistic monitoring of the UAE coastal areas; the development and dissemination of Ocean Science, and through scientific research and community engagement, the creation of the world's first Biofoundry dedicated to marine algae.

We will also engage with some mirror institutions from Paris universities which can develop transdisciplinary research in the field of the axes of the SUAD research Institute, such as:



##### **Centre du Droit des Affaires et de Gestion (CEDAG)**

The centre explores all areas of business activity in a cross-disciplinary way, from management to law, in a national and international context, taking into account the digital evolution of society.

##### **Institut d'Histoire du Droit (IHD)**

The Institute explores the history of modern and contemporary legal thought. It explores the history of legal thought in the broadest sense, including the contribution of the great jurists, the emergence and development of schools of thought, the production of legal works, the history of doctrinal currents, the history of concepts and manifestations of law since their genesis, and the dissemination of legal models.

##### **Centre Maurice Hauriou (CMH)**

A multi-disciplinary research centre, it covers all areas of public law and political science, focusing on five main areas: governance and public management, the State in Europe and globalisation, law and religion, law and geopolitics of the Arab world, energy markets and sustainable development law.

##### **Laboratoire Interdisciplinaire de Recherche Appliquée, Economie-Gestion et Santé (LIRAES)**

The Laboratoire is a transdisciplinary research unit that brings together teacher-researchers and researchers in economics, management and accounting to focus on the economic evaluation of healthcare policies and systems.

##### **Microeconomics, Institutions and Public Policies, and Decisions and Behaviour.**



### Transdisciplinary Research Training and Education

To become a world-class collaborative and transdisciplinary research institution, SUAD has identified the need to incorporate transdisciplinary research training and education into the curriculum to equip students with the essential skills and mindset required for successful international and interdisciplinary collaboration.

Similarly, we will foster a culture that encourages collaboration among academic disciplines, striving to create an environment where academics, researchers, students and society at large are inspired to work in unison, exchange ideas, and approach the intricate issues of today and tomorrow's society from diverse vantage points. This collective project could be achieved by developing specific areas for sharing and conviviality, cross-disciplinary seminars and by disseminating the main events and inputs through our website.

### Enhanced Research Infrastructure

SUAD is committed to investing in top-tier research infrastructure to ensure that all the requisite resources and technologies are accessible to researchers, students as well as to external partners. Over the next five years, our infrastructure will be developed to encompass state-of-the-art laboratories, data centres, and collaborative spaces, all designed to support the most exceptional interdisciplinary projects. Our research infrastructure will also align with the developments led



by Sorbonne Université (e.g. biofoundry industrial development) and collaboration will see the translation of these applications to align with the UAE specific environment in the fields of, amongst other things, space, marine studies and solar energy.

Investing in cutting-edge technologies and communication tools is fundamental to enable seamless collaboration between our researchers and institutions worldwide. We aim to develop international collaborations beyond what we have with our partner universities in Paris, by forging new research partnerships with other leading international institutions in the region.

### Diversity and Inclusion in Research

Diversity and inclusion are actively promoted within SUAD's research community, as we believe that a variety of perspectives and backgrounds enriches high-quality transdisciplinary research and foster a global perspective.

### Dissemination of Research Outcomes

Hosting international research symposia, conferences, and seminars is a tradition at SUAD as these events facilitate networking, future collaboration opportunities, and the dissemination of research results. Moreover, SUAD seeks to strengthen its connections with national research networks such as the University Climate Network (UCN) and global consortia, which often provide access to resources, funding opportunities, and platforms for sharing research results on a broader scale. Additionally, we underscore the importance of translating research findings into practical, globally applicable solutions. Our researchers are encouraged to effectively communicate their work to a broader audience, including decision makers, policymakers and the community at large by means as diverse as conferences, public debates or podcasts.

### Evaluation of Research Strategies

The effectiveness of our transdisciplinary research strategy will be continually assessed through regular evaluations. These evaluations will be based on conventional academic performance metrics and feedback from faculty and stakeholders, allowing us to ensure that our approach continues to meet the mission and vision of the University. SUAD will foster responsible, transparent and sustainable research assessment practices in line with the Coalition for Advancing Research Assessment (CoARA). The ten commitments of the Agreement on Reforming Research Assessment will be integrated into the University's practices whenever possible and relevant, in particular in the way project proposals are assessed and awarded.

By executing this comprehensive strategy, SUAD aims to not only achieve regional and global research excellence but also to make a substantial contribution to addressing the most pressing challenges of our time.



### III. PROMOTE OPEN SCIENCE

#### Strategies

Promoting open science entails creating an environment characterized by research transparency and accessibility. This necessitates a more robust commitment to open science which is outlined below.

##### RESEARCH LEADERSHIP FOR OPEN SCIENCE

SUAD will designate a leadership team to oversee open science and to develop a strategy for the University which outlines the vision for open science, specifically within the Research Institute and its Institutes, Centres, and Laboratories, and promotes and supports open science initiatives.

SUAD's research policy underscores the effective implementation of the open science vision across the entire university, mandating that researchers make their work open and accessible, whenever feasible.

SUAD also actively encourages the use of high-impact scientific journals according to international bibliometric rankings. These publications will be disseminated on open access databases.

##### TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT ON OPEN SCIENCE

Training programmes and workshops will be developed on open science practices for faculty, researchers, and students. Furthermore, open science principles will be integrated into study programmes and research methodology courses. This will be incorporated into programme and curricula reviews.

Fostering a culture of open science is paramount for SUAD, and the university will contribute to this goal by organizing seminars, workshops, and conferences to engage with the local and global research community to promote best practices. SUAD will work in conjunction with French and international actors to ensure that authors retain their rights when publishing.

##### RESEARCH REPOSITORY

As part of its open science strategy, SUAD will leverage existing repositories to create a university data repository for the storage and sharing of all research data. Additionally, SUAD will invest in collaborative platforms and tools that facilitate open collaboration and data sharing among researchers.

##### ETHICAL AND LEGAL COMPLIANCE

SUAD recognizes the ethical and legal concerns associated with open science, including data confidentiality, copyright compliance, and the collection of consent. The university is committed to addressing these issues fully and ethically and will implement measures to ensure that research is conducted with due respect for intellectual property rights.

##### PEER REVIEW OF OPEN RESEARCH

SUAD is equally dedicated to ensuring that open science practices do not compromise the quality of research. To ensure this, we will implement peer review and validation mechanisms for open research. Through the comprehensive implementation of our open science, we will nurture a culture of open science, transparency, and collaboration. This, in turn, will significantly contribute to the advancement of our research and the dissemination of knowledge on a global scale.





## IV. EXPAND RESEARCH NETWORKS AND PARTNERSHIPS

### Strategies

SUAD's mission is to serve as a hub of research excellence, and expanding our networks and partnerships will help fulfill this fundamental role. Establishing new research networks and partnerships will enable us to promote innovation, knowledge exchange, and global influence.

#### EXTENSION OF RESEARCH NETWORKS AND PARTNERSHIPS

In our strategic plan, SUAD is committed to enhancing collaboration with existing partners and creating new networks and research partnerships in specific research areas, and strategic geographical regions, including Europe, the MENA region, Asia, and Oceania.

Existing research collaborations with international institutions, which were originally established for specific research projects, will be expanded and formalized. This includes natural collaborations with universities and research institutes in France such as Sorbonne Université and Université Paris Cité and their worldwide networks of partners. Amongst these are the French National Museum of Natural History (MNHN) which has a strong research portfolio in biodiversity and natural protected areas, and the Institut de Physique du Globe de Paris (IPGP) which is at the forefront of research in Earth Sciences, Geophysics and the Environment.

SUAD will also continue to enhance its collaborations with local universities, including Khalifa University and the Rabdan Academy with whom it is partnering with on the development of the Zayed Military University, and the partner universities within the Universities for Climate Network (UCN).

New strategic research partnerships will be forged to create strategic synergies across all research domains present at SUAD and those the university intends to pursue in the future, in particular in the areas of engineering and artificial intelligence systems.

#### EXTENSION OF ENGAGEMENT WITH ALLIANCE SORBONNE UNIVERSITE RESEARCH INSTITUTES

Moreover, SUAD will increase engagement with the multidisciplinary research institutes, including Sorbonne Centre for Artificial Intelligence (SCAI), the Institut de l'Océan, and the Institut de la Transition Environnementale while advocating for more global research partnerships by participating in international consortia and alliances that resonate with the university's research priorities.

#### STRENGTHENING INDUSTRIAL PARTNERSHIPS

Strengthening industrial partnerships is another key priority of SUAD. This will include the creation of new research chairs similar to those already established with Thales and Total Energies to develop a research of excellence in the field of Artificial intelligence systems. Future partnerships with industry will be developed in key areas such as the blue economy field.

#### STRENGTHENING PARTNERSHIPS WITH GOVERNMENT ENTITIES

SUAD is actively working to develop partnerships with government entities in the UAE. This will be further enhanced to ensure that the cutting-edge research conducted at SUAD aligns with the UAE's national priorities and strategies.

To facilitate these endeavors, faculty and researchers will be actively encouraged to develop collaborations with colleagues and institutions worldwide. These efforts will be supported by the research support centre to ensure the provision of adequate resources and assistance to establish these connections.

By implementing this strategy, SUAD will build a dynamic and extensive network of research partnerships, ultimately enhancing the impact and reputation of its research on a global scale. These partnerships will enable collaborative efforts to address complex global challenges and advance knowledge worldwide.





## V. EMPOWER RESEARCH AIMED AT THE ACHIEVEMENT OF THE UN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

### Strategies

SUAD's strategic plan outlines a strong commitment to advancing research for the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) which necessitates a global and interconnected approach. As part of its approach to developing this area of research, we have identified a number of specific SDGs which align with the strategic research themes of SUAD, and which we are committed to prioritizing.

#### ESTABLISHMENT OF A HUB DEDICATED TO THE UN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

To this end, SUAD will establish interdisciplinary research centres centered around specific sustainable development goals. These centres will serve as hubs for research initiatives linked to particular objectives, especially those aligned with the university's strategic partnerships as outlined above.

Similarly, SUAD will introduce research support programmes tailored to SDGs and areas of strategic research focus. In addition, themed «research funds» and grants will be designed specifically for these goals. Researchers will be encouraged to apply for grants designed specifically for their respective research goals.

#### DEVELOPMENT OF SDG-ORIENTED PARTNERSHIPS

SUAD's strategy also aims at forging partnerships with universities and organizations worldwide that share a commitment to the respective SDGs. Such partnerships will facilitate collaborative research projects, faculty and student exchange programmes, and the sharing of knowledge on these themes. One such example of this is the universities commitment to engage in advancing health-related research in response to SDGs 3 and 4. An interdisciplinary centre will bring together health researchers, teachers and students of the Health Economics Master's programme, and social and economic scientists to collaborate on projects addressing healthcare accessibility. Other similar endeavours will be developed to support key SDG achievements which will include the creation of a Biofoundry.

#### ETHICAL AND LEGAL COMPLIANCE

Ethical research practices will be of paramount importance, and SUAD will develop range of guidelines related to data confidentiality, informed consent, and ethical considerations when engaging with affected communities. For instance, in field research, whether in archaeology or marine explorations by the Institut de l'Océan, conservation efforts will align with SDGs 6 and 14. Data collection, especially in Sociology or Geography, will respect local customs and involve local community participation.

Furthermore, SUAD will establish a dedicated unit to produce evidence-based policy recommendations for government entities supporting the selected SDGs. This will ensure the integration of clean energy research, not only from a technical perspective through science teams but also from the standpoint

of public and economic policy development by social sciences, economics, and law researchers. This comprehensive approach will align with SDGs 7 and 16.

By implementing this strategic research policy, SUAD will strengthen research efforts across a range of SDGs, contributing to sustainable development progress on multiple fronts. The practical examples and illustrations ensure a holistic approach, addressing concrete challenges associated with each goal.





## VI. CREATE RESEARCH WITH INDUSTRIAL AND SOCIO-ECONOMIC SYNERGIES

### Strategies

SUAD's strategic plan aims to create research initiatives with strong industrial and socio-economic synergies. To achieve this objective, the university has identified the following actions, based on the strong relationship we have developed with Total and Thales.

#### DEVELOPMENT OF A PORTFOLIO OF PARTNERSHIPS

SUAD will develop a Portfolio of Partnerships. The University seeks to create a diverse network of partnerships, as mentioned above, that will support the development of research and enterprise activities with a significant impact at local, regional, and international levels.

These partnerships will span across various sectors including Engineering, Health, Biofoundry, and AI. They will comprise local and regional industries, research organizations, and a host of international collaborators. By nurturing these collaborations, the university aims to leverage its scientific expertise and resources to address real-world challenges, create innovative solutions, and drive socio-economic progress.

#### ESTABLISHMENT OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES TO DIVERSIFY INCOME

Developing a structured timetable for programme reviews is essential, and this schedule will be created in collaboration with all stakeholders to ensure that reviews occur regularly and become a routine part of the university's academic governance.

An integral part of programme reviewing will also ensure that those programmes which no longer meet market needs, and demonstrate declining student interest are critically assessed to determine whether they need to be redesigned or suspended.

SUAD will conduct routine reviews to ensure programme offerings align with research strengths and to support the development of new programmes around key research themes. In addition, reviews will be carried out to assess current trends, emerging industries, and employer demands to ensure sustained graduate employability. These reviews will follow a three-year cycle to maintain the responsiveness of programme offerings to market needs.

SUAD will implement a system for ongoing data collection that tracks employment trends, industry developments, and changing skill requirements. This continuous data collection will enable SUAD to make informed, evidence-based adjustments to its programme offerings.



#### PROGRAMME ADAPTATION AND INNOVATION: ALIGNING WITH MARKET EXPECTATIONS

Once programmes reviews are completed, SUAD will proactively take the necessary steps to align its programme offerings with the needs of the present and future market such as Archival Studies, Digital Humanities and Quantum Physics. This alignment will involve revising and enhancing existing programmes and, if necessary, introducing new programmes that align with market needs.

Pedagogical innovation will be a central component of programme reviews. This includes exploring modern teaching methodologies, technology-enhanced learning, and promoting cross-disciplinary approaches to enrich the learning experience.



## DEVELOPMENT OF A LEARNING AND TEACHING STRATEGY

SUAD is committed to continuous pedagogical renewal. To support this, we will develop a learning and teaching strategy that fosters the use of innovative tools to support technology enhanced learning.
