

overview

The Double Bachelor in Philosophy and Sociology is an exclusive three-year degree taught in French, that offers students the opportunity to work in a wide range of fields.

The curriculum combines the two joint bachelors (in Philosophy and Sociology) with an interdisciplinary minor in the social sciences, with courses in Political Science, Economics, Geopolitics, International Relations, Public Policy, History and Communication. It gives students the opportunity to thoroughly and rigorously learn about ethics, politics and social phenomena through the perspectives of philosophy and the social sciences.

The Philosophy curriculum emphasises epistemological questions regarding the conditions of scientific objectivity and the way social sciences differ from natural sciences. It explores moral and political issues including classical topics such as justice, freedom and equality, and theory of action (rational choice theory). It emphasises theory of knowledge, metaphysics, ethical and political

philosophy. It develops analytical and critical thinking, as well as research, argumentation and assessment capabilities, and allows students to question the theoretical foundations of key philosophical issues in the contemporary world, with a special focus on the challenges of environmental change and the development of artificial intelligence and the new technologies.

The Sociology curriculum emphasises the link between sociological theory and empirical research. Students learn the qualitative and quantitative methodologies of the social sciences and work on social contemporary phenomena such as social stratification, migration, urbanisation, health sociology, socio-cultural inequalities and the question of tolerance, and the socio-political changes in the context of our globalised world.

This double bachelor provides students with a deep and comprehensive understanding of the functioning of contemporary societies, and challenges them to think critically about key sociological and philosophical issues.

A mandatory language course offers students the opportunity to add an extra language to their skills. These language choices include Arabic, English, German, Italian, Chinese or Spanish. The programme faculty are all internationally renowned professors whose teaching methodology goes beyond the traditional forms of teaching to ensure a balanced and well-rounded learning experience. Personalised tutoring is also available for students to enjoy a more individual learning experience.

The curriculum follows the European ECTS system and the degree is awarded by Sorbonne University in Paris.

Career prospects

The degree prepares students for careers in governmental and non-governmental organisations, polling agencies, market research and statistics companies, diplomatic services, journalism, advertising and communication, secondary and higher education and research, consulting as well as human resources.

Admission requirements

To be eligible for this Bachelor's degree, students must have the following:

- French baccalaureate: minimum average of 12 out of 20.
- Ministry of Education curriculum: General stream/Art stream: minimum average of 80%.
- Advanced stream/Elite stream/Science stream: minimum average of 75%.
- Other high school systems: high school certificate equivalent to the UAE Ministry of Education high school with minimum average of 80% or equivalent.
- French Aptitude Certificate: minimum score
 of B2 level (DELF or DALF, SELFEE, TCF with
 a validity of 2 years, TEF with a validity of
 2 years) or completion of SUAD university
 diploma DU in French language for nonFrench speakers. Students with a French
 Baccalaureate are exempted from the
 language proficiency exam.

students not meeting the required French Aptitude Certificate will be admitted conditionally in the programme, and enrolled in the foundation year in intensive French providing they meet the above criteria: Upon its successful completion, they will be admitted into the bachelor degree programme.


