Overview

Created in 2019 by Sorbonne University in Paris and Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi, the Sorbonne Center for Artificial Intelligence (SCAI) is a center of excellence dedicated to research in artificial intelligence. Under the direction of Professor Gérard Biau, a member of the Academy of Sciences and a specialist in statistics and machine learning, and Dr. Xavier Fresquet, a research engineer in AI & Humanities, SCAI's mission is to develop the research ecosystem in the United Arab Emirates and strengthen bilateral scientific cooperation. In Abu Dhabi, SCAI is located on Sorbonne University Abu Dhabi's campus.

A pioneering research center dedicated to artificial intelligence in the United Arab Emirates, SCAI has paved the way for a rapidly growing ecosystem and has helped train the next generation of Emirati researchers. Since then it is a key actor of the local AI ecosystem alongside the Mohammed Bin Zayed University for Artificial Intelligence (MBZUAI), contributing to the development of the AI research landscape and its integration into strategic sectors.



A Research Hub Between France and the UAE

As a catalyst for scientific collaboration between France and the UAE, SCAI is fostering an advanced research ecosystem.

By leveraging the combined expertise of both countries and upholding the standards of French research excellence, it plays a key role in advancing AI expertise in the region.

Since its creation, SCAI has benefited from the support of major industrial players such as TotalEnergies and Thales, which fund two research chairs of excellence. These chairs specifically support four PhD students, whose work focuses on AI applications in the energy and security sectors.

In 2024 SCAI was recognized as a national center of excellence in AI through the AI Cluster Program launched by French President Macron, receiving public-private funding of 70 million euros.



A Hybrid Model Supporting the UAE's Strategic Ambitions

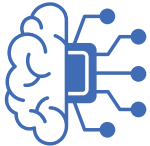

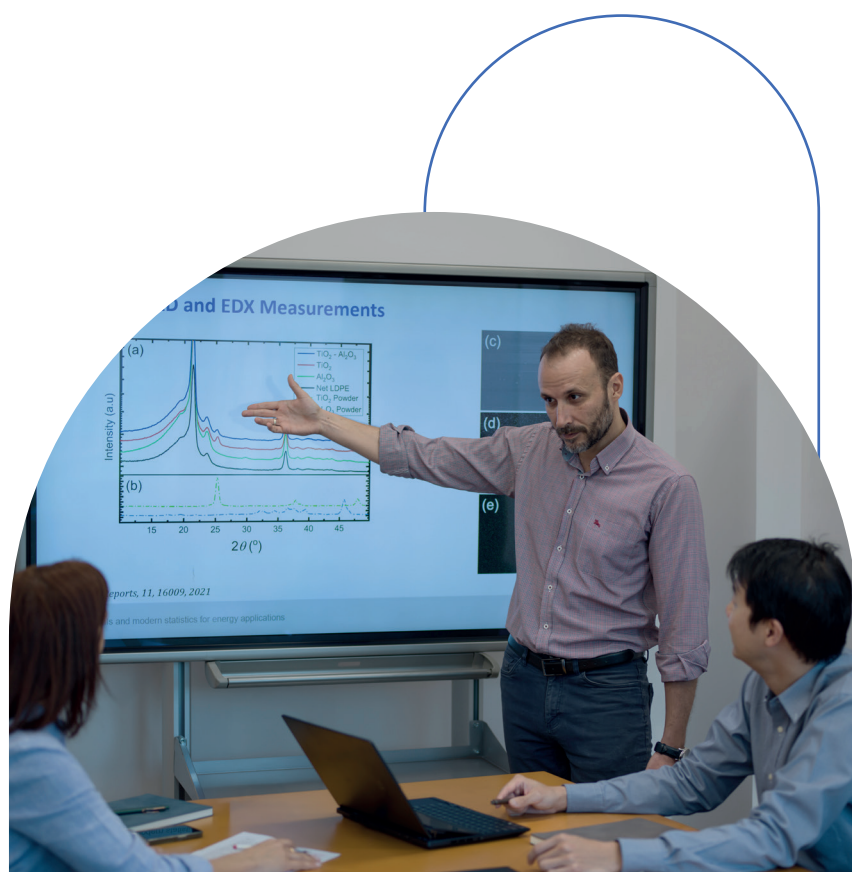
